

# Don't Lose Your Fur Friend

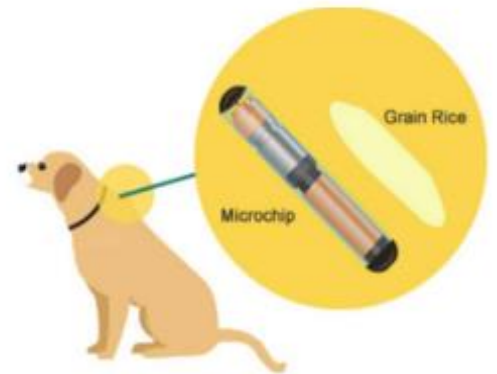
## 🐾 Get a collar with dog ID tags, QR code

- 🐾 Easy to scan and contact pet owner



## 🐾 Microchip your dog

- 🐾 Tiny Transponder - Rice grain size
- 🐾 Inside skin - between shoulder blades
- 🐾 Unique Id read through reader
- 🐾 Id retrieves pet owner contact information
- 🐾 No batteries or electric charge and lasts up to 25 years



## 🐾 Use Smart Tracker

- 🐾 Tracks pet location and health
- 🐾 Updates on smartphone and other devices

## 🐾 Secure yard and home

- 🐾 Fence front and backyard
- 🐾 Secure

## 🐾 Make sure to spay or neuter

- 🐾 Keeps them from wandering off and getting lost
- 🐾 Prevents overpopulation

## 🐾 Learn and teach your pet basic commands

- 🐾 Train your pet on 2 essential commands **Come** and **Stay**

## 🐾 Beware of scams

- 🐾 If a stranger claims to have found your dog, ask them to describe your pet and send you a photo
- 🐾 Be wary of anyone who asks for money before they'll return your dog
- 🐾 Many experts recommend that you omit one identifying characteristic when advertising a lost pet
- 🐾 Be skeptical of anyone who claims to have found your pet but can't describe this characteristic.
