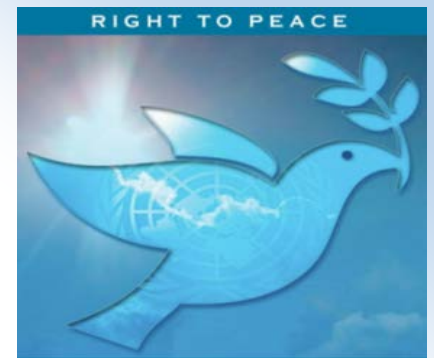

Mission Statement:

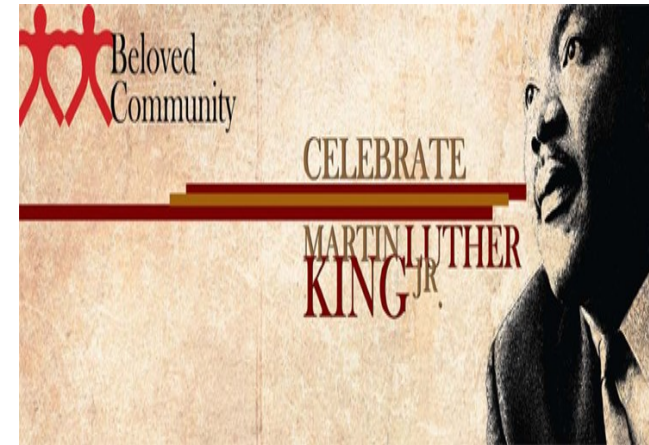
Raising West Windsor Township's awareness of cultural diversity and building positive community relationships in an effort to enhance the quality of life in our township.
