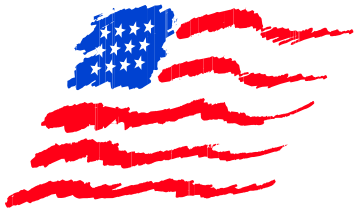


Am I eligible to serve?

Yes! If you are registered to vote in Mercer County. (Except for participants in the high school work program.)

Yes! If you are able to read and write legibly.

Yes! If you can lift at least 25 lbs (the weight of a voting machine) without difficulty.



What Do I Have To Do?

- *Report to your assigned polling place by 5:15 a.m. on Election Day.
- *Prepare the polling area for the voters.
- *Set up voting equipment and supplies.
- *Open the Polls and process the Voters who come in.
- *Enjoy your one hour meal break during the day.
- *Close the Polls and complete final paperwork.
- *Pick up and/or return books and supplies to the municipal clerk. (1 or 2 persons needed)

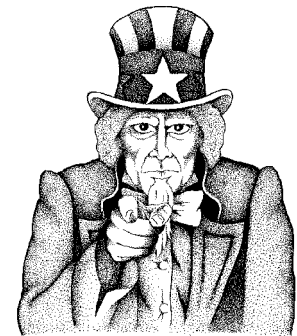

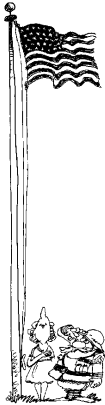

What Training Do I Need?

By law, Boardworkers must attend a Training Class every two years or when there is a significant change in election procedures.

Classes are held two times a year and last about two hours.

Board workers are instructed on their duties regarding voting machines, provisional ballots and registration books.

Board workers are also provided with reference materials including election day helpline contacts.

When Will I Be Needed?

Boardworkers are needed for the...

February Presidential Primary
(every 4 years starting in 2008)

School Board Elections

Municipal Elections

June Primary Election

November General Election



What is the Compensation?

Boardworkers receive \$200.00 for the entire day (must be at the polling location from 5:15 a.m. to about 8:30 p.m.)

Where Will I Work?

In a District that may need additional help or where a vacancy exists. Each District may have four Boardworkers, two Democrats and two Republicans. Consideration is given to place Boardworkers in or close to the town where they live. New Boardworkers are placed with Experienced ones.
