

PSE&G Announces Transmission Tower Facilities Work

PSE&G announces that their Contractors are beginning right-of-way surveying and preliminary investigations of subsurface conditions and underground utilities along their Metuchen-Trenton-Burlington (MTB) transmission line, which includes the stretch through West Windsor Township and the Trolley Line Trail property. The MTB Project is designed to strengthen PSE&G's electric transmission system for customers in this region. The 55-mile reliability project, which runs from PSE&G's Metuchen Switching Station in Edison to Burlington Switching Station in Burlington, replaces critical infrastructure that has reached its end of life. On average, these transmission facilities are 80-plus years old. PSE&G is aware that the work through West Windsor Township requires the appropriate approvals from the appropriate Land Use board. No applications to the Township have been prepared or submitted to date.
