



Paint Disposal Advisory

As a reminder to our residents, West Windsor has specific guidelines on how to dispose of paint. Only latex paint can be disposed of during regular trash pickup.

Latex paint: Latex paint only (empty cans or completely absorb paint with kitty litter or sand and place open cans on ground (not in bags or cans) for trash pickup. Do not place large quantities of paint cans out for disposal - please notify West Windsor Public Works (609-799-8370) if you have a large quantity of paint cans.

Liquids of any type often spill when the truck compacts the trash. The trucks are not watertight and the liquid spills all over the roadway. Paint actually coats the roadway and can only be removed through milling.

Oil based paint is considered hazardous waste and must be disposed of at the Mercer County Improvement Authority (MCIA) bi-annual Hazardous Waste Day. For more information, call 278-8086 or check the MCIA web site at <http://www.mcia-nj.com/recyclinghazwastedisposal.asp>
