AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT
THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES
OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST WINDSOR (2008)

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A SALARY AND WAGE PLAN FOR
