Howard took part in the Vera Cruz, Mexico landing and also landed in Monrovia, Liberia, in 1915. During World War I, he served on destroyers convoying troops to Europe. He also served on the USS Cruiser Trenton on it's cruise around Africa in 1924. During World War II he served on duty, laying submarine and torpedo nets in the European theater. After 33 years of distinguished service in the Navy, Chief Boatswain's Mate Howard Bradbury retired from the Naval Reserve. He was a member of American Legion, Hamilton Township Post 31, then transferred to Ewing Township Post 314. His grandchildren affectionately called him Boatsy.
